ALTERNATIVE DRIVING ROUTES FROM BEAVERDAM RUN

If you need to leave Beaverdam Run, and Beaverdam Rd. is blocked at some point, there are alternative routes both to the east (left from the exit) and to the west (right from the exit). Some of the alternative roads are narrow, one is unpaved, and all are twisty, unlit, and hilly (thus unlikely choices in the event of heavy snow or icy conditions).

To the <u>left</u> from our exit (east), drive a very short distance to the split in the road and take the right branch, Webb Cove Rd. After some distance it becomes an unpaved road up the mountain with many sharp, blind curves. At the top—another 2 miles or so—you have the option of taking the Blue Ridge Parkway in either direction (Asheville is to the right) or making a sharp right turn onto Town Mountain Road, which descends and eventually takes you to downtown Asheville via Tunnel Rd.

To the <u>right</u> from our exit (west), you have three options. All of these roads exit from the left side (south) of Beaverdam Rd and bring you eventually to **Kimberly Ave and Merriman Rd.** Starting with the nearest route (all mileages are approximate):

Using Beaverdam Knoll Rd.

- After 0.5 mi., turn left onto Beaverdam Knoll Rd.
- After 0.4 mi., turn right on Wolfe Cove Rd. and almost immediately left on Asbury Rd. (sign is not obvious)
- After 0.3 mi., turn left on Basset Rd., keeping to the right.
- After 0.1 mi., turn right onto Spooks Branch Rd.
- After 0.4 mi., turn left onto Spring Cove Rd.
- After 0.3 mi., turn right onto Grove Cove Dr.
- After 0.4 mi., turn right onto Patton Mtn. Rd. and almost immediately right onto N. Griffing Blvd., which winds down the mountain and, at 0.8 mi., briefly becomes a divided highway with plantings in the median.
- Continue 0.2 mi. from the median's end to Kimberly Ave.

Using Wolfe Cove Rd. (opposite fire department)

- Turn left (south) onto Wolfe Cove Rd.
- After less than 0.3 mi., turn right onto Basset Rd. and continue for 0.5 mi. through a 90-degree curve to Spooks Branch Rd.
- Turn right and, after 0.4 mi., turn left onto Spring Cove Rd.
- After 0.3 mi., turn right onto Grove Cove Dr.
- After 0.4 mi., turn right onto Patton Mtn. Rd. and almost immediately right onto Griffing Blvd., which winds down the mountain and, at 0.8 mi., briefly becomes a divided highway with plantings in the median.
- Continue 0.2 mi. from the median's end to Kimberly Ave.

Using Spooks Branch Rd.

- Turn left (south) onto Spooks Branch Rd. (just before The Timbers).
- After 0.5 mi., turn right onto Spring Cove Rd.
- After 0.3 mi., turn right onto Grove Cove Dr.
- After 0.4 mi., turn right onto Patton Mtn. Rd. and turn almost immediately right onto N. Griffing Blvd., which winds down the mountain and, at 0.8 mi., briefly becomes a divided highway with plantings in the median.
- Continue 0.2 mi. from the median's end to Kimberly Ave.

ALTERNATIVE DRIVING ROUTES TO BEAVERDAM RUN

If you need to return to Beaverdam Run and Beaverdam Rd. is blocked at some point, you can take the Blue Ridge Parkway to the Craven Gap exit and follow your nose down the **unpaved** road, which becomes Webb Cove Rd., and leads you to Beaverdam Rd. and our entrance (on the right).

-- OR --

You can take Kimberly Ave. north to the stop sign intersection with Gracelyn Ave. and Griffing Blvd.

- Turn away from Merrimon Ave. (northeast) onto Griffing Blvd.
- Go 0.3 mi. to the end of the median, bearing left (to avoid S. Griffing), then bear right at the Redwood intersection to stay on Griffing Blvd.
- After 0.2 mi., at a T intersection, turn left onto N. Griffing Blvd.
- After 0.7 mi., turn left onto Patton Mtn. Rd. (sign is hard-to-see) and immediately left onto Grove Cove Dr.
- Avoid left turn at 0.3 mi. and continue downhill 0.1 mi., turning left onto Spring Cove Rd
- After 0.3 mi., you will reach Spooks Branch Rd. Then take one of the following two routes:

For the most direct route to Beaverdam Rd.

- Turn left onto Spooks Branch Rd.
- After 0.2 mi., bear left.
- After 0.3 mi., turn right onto Beaverdam Rd.
- Turn left into our entrance.

For the route that avoids the longest stretch of Beaverdam Rd.

- Turn right onto Spooks Branch Rd.
- After 0.1 mi., turn left onto Basset Rd.
- After 0.1 mi., turn right on Asbury Rd.
- Almost immediately turn right at a T intersection onto Wolfe Cove Rd. and then left onto Beaverdam Knoll Rd. (sign is difficult to see)
- After 0.4 mi. turn right onto Beaverdam Rd.
- Turn left into our entrance.
